



Kindergarten Parade Promotion Ceremony FAQs

Bloom Academy is excited to each one of our amazing kindergarten scholars. We will be hosting a parade and a drive-up certificate ceremony. Below you will find answers to the a few common questions about the upcoming promotion ceremony:

1. What time does the parade begin?

The parade will begin at **1 pm on Saturday, June 6th at Bloom Academy**. As early as 12 pm, graduating scholars may be dropped off in front of the school and cars may begin lining up. Please be in line on time so that we can begin promptly.

2. Can other family members come to the event?

As many cars that would like to join the parade may do so. However, only one car per student with a kindergarten promotion car placard will be permitted to participate in the drive-up certificate ceremony.

3. How does the lineup work?

From 12-12:45 pm scholars should be dropped off in front of the school. After drop off, cars may join the parade line. A Bloom Academy team member will be on-site to direct traffic and answer questions.

4. How many times will the parade circle through the parking lot?

Twice - you may honk, cheer, and clap to make sure our scholars feel the joy!

5. What happens after we circle the parking lot the last time?

Cars with kindergarten promotion placards will make a line as is required for afternoon dismissal. A Bloom Academy team member call one car at a time up to the front of the building for the drive-up certificate ceremony.

6. What happens when our car is called up to the front door?

When your car is asked to pull up, family members may exit the car to take pictures of their scholar receiving their promotion certificate. All family members who exit the car should be wearing masks. Families may then take pictures for no more than three minutes.

7. What is the dress code?

All scholars are free to dress to impress! Each family will have a chance to take photos of their scholar before getting back into the car.
